INTRODUCTION

This training aims to strengthen Good Refrigeration Practices, including recovery and recycling, and retrofitting fixed and mobile systems using drop in replacement refrigerants by building on the progress that has already taken place under the training programs of the Refrigerant Management Plan (RMP) and utilizing the local capacity that was built under the said program.

Particular emphasis was placed on (i) the use of recovery and recycling machines, vacuum pumps, electronic scales, identifiers and leak detectors (ii) developing skills in retrofitting of fixed and MAC systems.

This training is integrated into the establishment of 13 recovery and recycling centers (10 domestic and commercial and 3 MAC). Participants attending the training were given detailed training in the use of the equipment. The managers and potential users of the recovery and recycling centers were all present to receive the training.
